



First Aid of Hope

Be prepared in season and out of season.

—2 Timothy 4:2

Many people, especially parents, make sure there are bandages, ointment, tweezers, and other items in a first aid kit in case of accidents. It is normal to prepare for unexpected accidents or changes, especially unwelcome ones. Nurse Clara Barton understood the necessity of being prepared for the unexpected. During the Civil War, she worked to aid injured soldiers who were brought into the hospital from the battlefields. But soon she saw a need to go to the battle lines to carry supplies and help the soldiers. Many times she arrived just when medical supplies and bandages had run out. Using her own funds, she risked her life to aid others. The soldiers called her "Angel of the Battlefield." Clara Barton later founded the American Red Cross. She devoted her life to being prepared to aid others.

It is always good to prepare your heart for unexpected changes. When life goes wrong, it can be devastating. Be prepared by staying in touch with friends and family so you can keep your support group strong. They will be there to lean on when you need them. Give thanks for all that you have and all those around you who help protect your hopes and keep you prepared.
